- Harvard University researchers have resolved a conflict in estimates of how much the Earth will warm in response to a doubling of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere, finding that long-term patterns of warming could lead to a 1.5 to 4.5 degrees Celsius increase in global temperature.
- The ancient mitochondrial DNA from the femur of an archaic European hominin recovered by scientists from the Max Planck Institute for the Science of Human History and Tubingen is helping to resolve the complicated relationship between modern humans and Neanderthals.
