the Samaj.

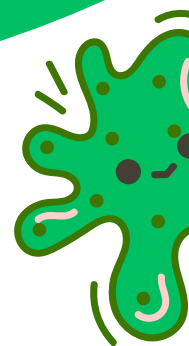
News at a Glance

Presentation by B.Sc. I Year Students: Personality development students presented the topics assigned to them as per the new NEP syllabus.

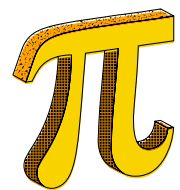

- Worked as a Master Trainer in B.L.O training programme from 09 - 16 September 2025 appointed by Collector, and District Election officer.

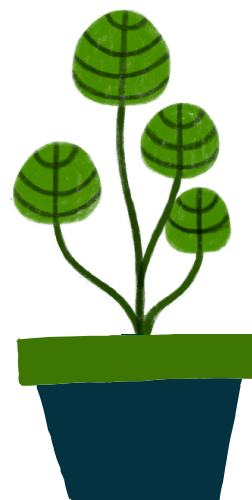
Dr. Madhavi Adhav was appointed as the convener of UG Academic Development Programme and college Knowledge Gallery for the current academic session.

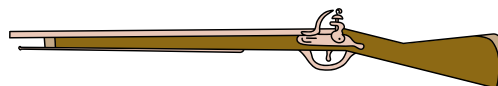

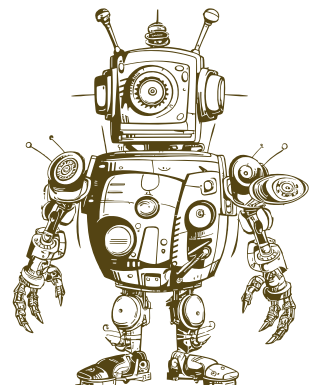


DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND IT

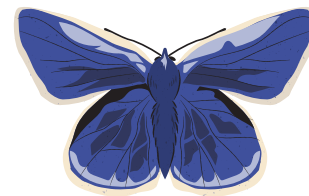
